WHEREAS – Passenger Rail service is now acknowledged as an environmentally and economically friendly means of transportation service

WHEREAS - The Northlander link to Cochrane and connection to the Polar Bear Express provided a seamless rail connection from Toronto to James Bay, providing residents of the James Bay region economical access to Urban Centres

WHEREAS – The Northlander link to Cochrane and connection to the Polar Bear Express provided a seamless rail connection for Thousands of Ontario, Canadian, and international Tourists to visit Cochrane and The James Bay Communities, driving \$Millions in economic activity and service development.

WHEREAS – The rail passenger volume due to a seamless connection of the Northlander to the Polar Bear express is a critical, sustainable customer base for the long term viability of the Northlander rail service
